Help us ensure your child's swim is a safe one!

In order to provide the safest possible environment for children to enjoy the many benefits of swimming, Lisburn City Council continues to follow the "Best Practice Guidelines" issued by the Institute of Sport and Recreation Management (ISRM).

As a result of these "Guidelines", a Child Admissions Policy will apply to the Leisure, Competition and Diving/Learner Pools.

What is the Child Admissions Policy for the Lagan Valley LeisurePlex?

1. All children under 4 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult / person (over 16 years), on a one to one basis, when using the competition, diving/learner and leisure pools.
2. Children aged between 4-7 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult/person (over 16 years) with a maximum of 2 children being supervised by one adult.
 - The requirements of the Child Admissions Policy mean that for example one adult, will not be able to gain admission to the water with three children under 8 years and that a child under 4 years and one between 4-7 years must be accompanied by 2 responsible adults.
3. During Lazy River Family Sessions in the leisure pool and Adult and Child Sessions in the learner pool, a responsible adult/person (over 16 years) may accompany a maximum of 2 children into the water.
4. All children under 5 years have free admission to all LeisurePlex pools.
