About the Opportunity:

The 24 powered wheelers will be used by ODA staff prior to (where required) and during Games time. The vehicles will be used for business use only, on the venue sites, between the venues sites and to transport people/goods to the venues sites where required.

Description	12 powered two wheelers and 12 powered four wheelers of various engine sizes and specifications. The vehicles are required between October 2010 and October 2012 for various periods of time. All vehicles are required on a monthly hire basis with no surrender fees and no minimum lease length. The hire must also include the safety wear/equipment for the powered two wheelers and the maintenance, repair and service of all hired vehicles.
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About the buyer's selection process:

The Olympic Delivery Authority will award contracts to

businesses that reflect London 2012's procurement policies and values. Value for money on costs, time, quality, design and functionality, the promotion of equality and diversity, environmental responsibility, and legacy are key values that embody the ODA's procurement objectives.

Following shortlisting conducted on the CompeteFor system, you will be required to submit a quote directly to the ODA procurement manager. You will be instructed further on this process following shortlisting.

During the procurement process suppliers may be required to provide supporting evidence within 24 hours, there may also be an additional stage added following shortlisting and prior to the quotation stage.

Post the Tender closing date, all suppliers will be notified of their status via email and will be able to view who the opportunity was awarded to.
