## When?



### From 30th April 2007

it will be against the law to smoke in most indoor places other than your own private home.

## Where?



**Places of work** e.g. offices, factories and hospitals.

**Work vehicles** used by more than one person e.g. cars, lorries and vans.

**Public transport vehicles** e.g. buses, taxis, trains and minibuses.

**Public places** e.g. restaurants, bars, hotels, bingo halls, community halls, shopping centres and amusement arcades.

## Who?



Lisburn City Council's Environmental Health Service will enforce the law.

## What?



### If you break the law

by smoking in a smoke-free place you may be issued with a fixed penalty notice or be prosecuted. If you own or manage smoke-free premises or vehicles and you allow someone to smoke there, you may be prosecuted.

## Why?



**To protect workers and the public** from the serious health effects of second-hand smoke.
